1. Abstract Must be written in English only. It must be typed within the frame in the Abstract Form (using Arial font and in 11 points). Please restrict the abstract to the space given for it. Leave no margin at the top and left hand side. Care must be taken when typing the submission, which will be directly photo-printed.
2. The title must be in CAPITAL LETTERS on the first line it should be short and concise.
3. The names of authors should follow immediately under the title. The initials and family name of the authors in CAPITAL LETTERS and underline the presenting author. Do not use degrees of professional titles. The names of institutions, city and country should be in lower case, following immediately after the authors.
4. The abstracts should contain:
 - Objectives
 - Methods/Materials
 - Results
 - A summary of conclusions
 - Recommendations
5. Do not include graphs, tables or references in the abstract.
6. Use single-line vertical spacing and leave one line between paragraphs.
7. Abstracts are subject to approval by the organizing committee and the decision made will be final.
8. Only authors who have paid the registration fee are entitled to submit an abstract. Authors will be notified of acceptance or rejection.

Indore - Sight Seeing

RAJWADA:



Located in the heart of the city, this two-century old, seven-storeyed place is one of the most admired heritage of Holkar dynasty. The architecture is a mixture of Muslim, Maratha and French styles.

LAL BAGH PALACE:

Build between 1886 and 1921, it is one of the grandest monuments from Holkar dynasty. It reflects the taste, grandeur and lifestyle of the Holkars. The entrance gates are the replica of those at Buckingham Palace. It has now been converted into a museum housing exquisite memorabilia from the period.



KRISHNAPURA CHHATRIS:



The Chhatris are elegantly built cenotaphs of the last three Holkar rulers. Built on the banks of Khan river, its illumination at night makes it a breathtaking sight.

BADA GANPATI:

It is perhaps the biggest Ganesh idol in the world, measuring 25 feet from foot to crown. Built in 1875, it is made up of soil collected from the seven sacred cities of India, powder of Panchratna, holy water from pilgrimages, bricks, limestone and masala made of jaggery and fenugreek seeds. Its metallic frame is made of Panchdhatu.



KAANCH MANDIR:



This architectural marvel in glass is a quaint Jain shrine. Thousands of mirrors adorn the walls, ceilings, floors, pillars and door-knobs, supplemented by coloured, patterned ceramic tiles depicting scenes from Jain scriptures.

GOMMATGIRI:

It is the most sacred Jain temple in the city, having a 21 feet statue of Lord Gomateshwar which is a replica of Bahubali statue at Shravanbelgola. Also built are 24 temples dedicated to each Tirthankar.



Nearby Sight Seeing

UJJAIN - MAHAKAL TEMPLE



The presiding deity of time, Shiva, in all His splendour, reigns eternal in Ujjain. It is about 56 kms from Indore. The Mahakaleshwar temple enshrines one of India's twelve jyotirlingams, believed to derive currents of shakti (power) from within themselves as opposed to lingam ritually invested with mantra shakti by the priests.

MANDU -

98 kms from Indore, Mandu is a celebration in stone of life and joy. It is a tribute to the love shared between the poet-prince Baz Bahadur and his beautiful consort Rani Roopmati. It was originally the fort capital of the Parmar rulers of Malwa. This deserted fort has the ruins of many palaces, baths & pavilions.



MAHESHWAR -



91 kms from Indore, situated on the banks of River Narmada, this spectacular temple town is mentioned in the Ramayana and the Mahabharata. It languished in obscurity for many centuries and was revived by the Holkar queen Rani Ahilyabai of Indore in the 18th century. It has some very beautiful ghats and temples. Hand woven Maheshwari Sarees are a must buy which present a kaleidoscope of colours and designs.

OMKARESHWAR

78 kms east of Indore, the sacred island of Omkareshwar, shaped like the holy Hindu symbol 'Om' at the confluence of river Narmada & Kaveri, is get in picturesque surroundings. According to Hindu mythology, it is a very sacred pilgrimage as it houses one of the twelve jyotirlingams of India.
